## NPFSC Anglers

For the new Fishing season get the App for all the rules and practices.

### • CLEANING YOUR FISH

Catches of certain fish species must be retained either whole or in carcass form.

#### Carcass form (scale fish) =

The body of a fish which is not cut or mutilated in any manner other than to remove the gut, gills or scales.

Eg. ... Flathead, Dusky Flathead, King George whiting, Snapper.

#### Carcass (sharks including elephant fish) =

The body of a shark or elephant fish which is not cut

or mutilated in any manner other than to remove the gut and head forward and clear of the rearmost gill slit.

### WHO DOESN'T NEED A FISHING LICENCE

- Under 18 years of age.
- 70 years of age or over.
- The holder of a Seniors Card or Interstate equivalent.
- The holder of a Veterans' Affairs Pensioner Card.
- The holder of a Veterans' Affairs Repatriation Health Card (TPI).
- The holder of a Commonwealth Pensioner Concession Card relating to age, disability or career status, coded DSP, AGE, CAR.

## SHARKS, SKATES AND RAYS

### Measuring your catch

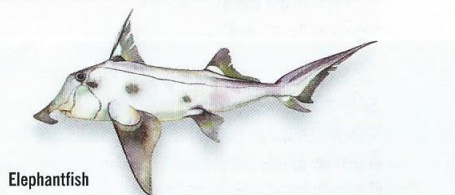
**Shark:** Measure shark from the rear most gill slit to the base of the tail fin on any side of the body.

#### Elephantfish

Scientific name: *Callorhynchus milii*

Minimum legal size: no minimum

Bag/possession limit: 1. Retained whole or in carcass form (see definition of carcass on page 21).



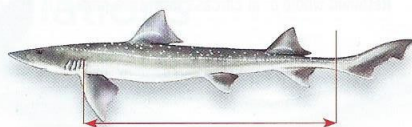
Elephantfish

#### Gummy shark

Scientific name: *Mustelus antarcticus*

Minimum legal size: 45 cm (partial length)

Bag/possession limit: a total limit of 2 for gummy shark and/or school shark. Retained whole or in carcass form (see page 21).



Gummy shark - Minimum legal size: 45 cm (partial length)

#### School (snapper) shark

Scientific name: *Galeorhinus galeus*

Minimum legal size: 45 cm (partial length)

Bag/possession limit: a total limit of 2 school shark and/or gummy shark. Retained whole or in carcass form (see page 21).



School shark - Minimum legal size: 45 cm (partial length)

#### MURRAY COD

Min legal size: 55cm

Max legal size: 75cm

From the Murray bag limit Is 1

A heavy trace of 40+ no swivel to a size 4 Mustard red bait holder

Size 2 – 5 ball sinker with a hard bead to stop sinker at the hook.

Remember you will be fishing in snags.

What bait to use?

Shrimp, freshwater yabbies, bardi grubs, scrub worms and cheese,

Yes cheese, the shrimp love it and Cod love shrimp.
